Hospital Property Surveillance System



Case study

Background

An established and well-respected hospital in the Midwest sought to extend the reach of its video surveillance system to the hospital's vast employee parking area. The primary objective was to maximize the safety of all hospital employees while strengthening the fabric of the hospital security network as a whole.

The Challenge

Since trenching and running a cable from the hospital's main building to the parking areas proved to be far too costly both in terms of budget and time/effort, the hospital was faced with identifying a solution that would not only provide a secure method of transmission, but do so without breaking the bank.

The Solution

A wireless surveillance solution comprised of two KBC WES-2 point-to-point systems serving a network of megapixel cameras was installed to monitor both the primary employee park area and the access gates in multiple areas, transmitting signals approximately 1,000 feet to the main building.

Outcome

Today, the installed wireless video surveillance system is working to protect the hospital's most valuable asset - the employees. The hospital is very pleased with the coverage they received from the new wireless camera system, and the integrator driving the project was impressed with both ease of installation of the system and the support they received from KBC from start to finish.
